Dear Parents,

This important information is shared with our students over the public address system throughout the year:

*Students, I want to discuss with you important information regarding possession of illegal substances. Many students are prescribed medication that is taken daily either at home or under the direction of the nurse at school. If it is necessary to take medication at school the guidelines outlined on page 55 (high school) 42 (intermediate) must be followed. All medication must be brought to the clinic by a parent and picked up by a parent.*


*Students, you cannot be casual about your medication. For example, we have had students in the past who were prescribed a medication known as Adderall. If a student, who is prescribed Adderall, brings it to school and passes it to another student, then both students are subject to expulsion from school. It is a felony offense to possess Adderall not prescribed for you. It is also a felony offense to deliver Adderall even if it is prescribed for you.*

*Should you have any questions regarding drugs and or consequences, please see your counselor or assistant principal. It is our mission to keep Klein Forest High School a drug free environment and I ask that you do your part to make this happen.*
